


Despite objections, Democratic National Committee (DNC) officials finally announced last Tuesday that the platform was passed by convention delegates and adopted. But despite inquiries by Fox News and other news organizations, they didn't release the roll-call vote on the platform for days. It is not unanimity for sure.

The tally is now out—and it reflects a major divide among delegates. The DNC revealed over the weekend that 3,562 delegates voted to approve the platform, while a total of 1,069 voted no, and 87 abstained. If you read the platform it may surprise you that 3562 people would go for an anti-American platform but they probably all have university degrees.

The number of convention delegates who voted no is roughly the same as the number of delegates pledged to socialist Bernie Sanders. Most know that the socialist / populist lawmaker and "Medicare-forall" champion was the last remaining rival to Democratic nominee Joe Biden in the primaries before Sanders suspended his White House bid and endorsing the former vice president in April.

Nonetheless, Democrats saw fit to meet remotely Monday afternoon July 27, 2020, to approve a lengthy policy platform that attempts to balance the interests of the Democratic Party's more moderate and liberal factions. The virtual meeting came three weeks ahead of what was to go down in history as what most pundits have labeled "the strangest party conventions in U.S. history."

Think about it, unlike normal convention features, it featured no delegates and besides that very few Democratic dignitaries chose to travel to Milwaukee to nominate former Vice President Joe Biden to be the party's standard-bearer. Instead, the convention as held mostly remotely. Biden himself was in Delaware. Under day four's theme of an "America's Promise," Biden assumed center stage at the Chase Center in Delaware -- more than 800 miles away from Milwaukee

The Dem platform, released as noted in July drew heavily from a report issued by joint task forces organized by Biden and his onetime campaign rival, Vermont Sen. Bernie Sanders. Some say it's 99% Bernie and 1% Biden. Its objective theoretically was to bridge the gap between Sanders' progressive politics and Biden's more moderate approach to governing.

Dozens of Democratic members considered amendments to the plan. They approved amended language opposing President Trump's deployment of federal agents to quell protests in Portland and other cities, as well as planks affirming support for unions, and for

expanding paid sick leave. By Monday evening, the Democratic National Committee had not shared the exact language of the amendments.

Think about that for a bit.

After a week of the Republicans hammering the Democrats on no acknowledgment of the looting and the riots, the Democrats have only a call to relax restrictions on the thugs terrorizing American cities.

With Democrats recognizing their polling is suffering from their stance on what the Republicans call their anti-American stance on protecting America's cities from thugs and looters, some of us expected they would shy away from memorializing their opposition to help to quell the disruption and the violence. They did but there it is in their platform.

The document released in July endorsed universal health care and technically made it clear that low- or no-cost coverage for every American is the party's eventual goal – Single. Rather than backing a single mandatory government-run health insurance program, however, it calls for adding a public option to the existing Affordable Care Act.


Democratic candidates had run and in 2018 had won on a promise to fight to give all Americans access to government-run health care. A new Medicare-for-all bill in the House had more than 100 cosponsors. But there were still real disagreements among Democrats. I guess it is a sign that not all Democrats are loony birds.

The platform does take a big nod to "Medicare for All," the policy backed by Bernie Sanders, saying: "We are proud our party welcomes advocates who want to build on and strengthen the Affordable Care Act and those who support a Medicare for All approach."

The platform also sets aggressive goals for combating climate change, including making all American power plants carbon neutral by 2035 and adding 500 million solar panels and 60,000 wind turbines to the country's electricity grid within the next five years.




Biden offers a \$2 trillion climate plan. The platform also calls for a \$15 minimum wage, mandatory paid family leave, more federal gun control (Beto O'Roarke, Biden's to-be gun czar announced he is coming to get your guns earlier in the year. and that has not changed.), broad changes to federal sentencing guidelines and drug laws, and many other changes that most Democratic candidates for Congress and the White House have supported for years.

Platform committee co-chair Denis McDonough, who served as former President Barack Obama's chief of staff, called it the "boldest Democratic platform in American history." Republicans call it anti-American in its total flavor.

There are major differences between the Democrat and Republican Party platforms. Democrats are still as liberal and as progressive as possible. Republicans had a lot of twists and wrinkles included in their convention platform and so the rest of this book will highlight the speeches given by the speakers at the RNC Convention. # Chapter 3 Democratic and Republican **Party Platforms**

Many decisions are made at the president's desk, but the major political party to which he or she belongs wields significant power over which domestic and international policies are advanced and what becomes law. Here is a summary of the Democratic and Republican party positions on some of the vital issues facing the country. As Franklin Graham has stated clearly many times, he is not endorsing any candidate or party in his analysis in this chapter..

## Sanctity of human life

#### **Democratic**

Democrats seek to repeal the 1976 Hyde Amendment so that federal funds can be used to pay for abortions. The platform says, "We will continue to stand up to Republican efforts to defund Planned Parenthood health centers." Democrats support ratification of UN efforts that affirm "the reproductive rights of women" globally.

## Republican

The GOP asserts the sanctity of human life and affirms, "The unborn child has a fundamental right to life which cannot be infringed." The party supports a Human Life Amendment making clear that the 14th Amendment's protections apply to children before birth, and it salutes states that require informed consent, parental consent, waiting periods and clinic regulation.

## Marriage

#### **Democratic**

Democrats applaud last year's Supreme Court ruling that "LGBT people—like other Americans—have the right to marry the person they love."

#### Republican

The GOP platform condemns the Supreme Court's rulings that removed the ability of Congress and the people to define marriage as the union of one man and one woman. The GOP urges the reversal of those decisions, whether through judicial reconsideration or a constitutional amendment.

## Religious freedom

#### **Democratic**

The Democratic platform says: "We support a progressive vision of religious freedom that respects pluralism and rejects the misuse of

religion to discriminate." The party opposes a religious test to bar immigrants or refugees from entering the country.

## Republican

Republicans affirm that religious freedom in the Bill of Rights protects the right of the people to practice their faith in their everyday lives. The platform endorses the First Amendment Defense Act, which would protect faith-based institutions and individuals from government discrimination.

## Federal judges

#### **Democratic**

The platform says: "We will appoint judges who defend the constitutional principles of liberty and equality for all, and will protect a woman's right to safe and legal abortion."

## Republican

The GOP platform states: "A critical threat to our country's constitutional order is an activist judiciary that usurps powers properly reserved to the people through other branches of government." The GOP supports the appointment of justices and judges who respect the constitutional limits on their power and respect the authority of the states.

## National defense

#### **Democratic**

The Democratic platform says that while the military is crucial, decreased military spending is necessary. The party also favors reducing excessive spending on nuclear weapons. The platform notes that it is "proud of the repeal of Don't Ask Don't Tell and the opening of combat positions to women."

## Republican

The Republican platform favors building and maintaining a strong military as the path to peace and security. The party seeks to restore the nation's military might and to rebuild troop numbers. The GOP would abandon treaties that benefit adversaries and would modernize the U.S. nuclear arsenal.

## **Terrorism**

#### **Democratic**

The Democratic platform uses firm language to say we "must defeat" global terrorism, though noting a preference for "diplomacy and development, to confront global threats and ensure war is a last resort." The party favors improving international intelligence capabilities to defend against external and homegrown threats.

## Republican

The GOP asserts that the Iran deal does not have treaty status and has only emboldened the regime in Tehran in sponsoring terrorism. The platform says, "We must stand up for our friends, challenge our foes, and destroy ISIS." It calls for governmental aid to Christian communities under genocidal attack in cities like Erbil.

## Human rights

#### **Democratic**

The Democratic platform recognizes gay rights as a human right, and party leaders have tied international development funds in poor countries to adherence to the LGBT agenda. According to the platform, "We will continue to stand with LGBT people around the world, including fighting efforts by any nation to infringe on LGBT rights or ignore abuse."

#### Republican

The GOP platform states: "To those who stand in the darkness of tyranny, America has always been a beacon of hope, and so it must remain." The party seeks a radical rethinking of our human rights diplomacy, adopting a "whole of government" approach in which

human rights issues are integrated at every appropriate level of our relationships with other nations.

## **Immigration**

#### **Democratic**

The party platform denounces Donald Trump's suggested ban on immigrants from countries (mostly Muslim) known to train and equip terrorists.

## Republican

Republicans oppose any form of amnesty for those who have entered illegally. The party supports building a border wall and refusing entrance to refugees who cannot be carefully vetted, especially those whose homelands have "been the breeding grounds for terrorism."

## Internet safety and decency

#### Democratic

The platform supports "a free and open internet at home and abroad." The party would seek to strengthen cybersecurity while "protecting the privacy and civil liberties of the American people."

#### Republican

The platform states: "The internet must not become a safe haven for predators. Pornography, with its harmful effects, especially on children, has become a public health crisis that is destroying the lives of millions."

## Addressing poverty

#### **Democratic**

Democrats will "direct more federal resources to lifting up communities that have been left out and left behind." The party would build more affordable rental housing units and seek to "create good-paying jobs and enhance opportunities by investing in small

business, youth employment, and reentry programs for formerly incarcerated people."

## Republican

The GOP says that instead of government handouts that keep people dependent, "We propose ... the dynamic compassion of work requirements in a growing economy, where opportunity takes the place of a hand-out, where true self-esteem can grow from the satisfaction of a job well done."

## Law and order

#### **Democratic**

The Democratic platform seeks to abolish the death penalty, "which has proven to be a cruel and unusual form of punishment. It has no place in the United States of America." The party would reform mandatory minimum sentences, close private prisons, end racial profiling and train officers in de-escalation.

#### Republican

The GOP decries the creation of new "crimes" by unelected civil servants and political appointees and sees this as federal overreach. The platform emphasizes restorative justice, including guidance by faith-based institutions. It notes that the death penalty is firmly settled by the Fifth Amendment and opposes efforts to erode this right.

## Israel and Jerusalem

#### Democratic

The platform states: "We will always support Israel's right to defend itself, including by retaining its qualitative military edge, and oppose any effort to delegitimize Israel. ... While Jerusalem is a matter for final status negotiations, it should remain the capital of Israel, an undivided city accessible to people of all faiths."

## Republican

Republicans express "unequivocal support for Israel," pointing out that it is the only Middle Eastern country with freedom of speech and freedom of religion. The GOP recognizes "Jerusalem as the eternal and indivisible capital of the Jewish state." The party opposes the U.N.'s treatment of Israel as a pariah state.

## The Rest of the Convention Overview




governor about safety protocols related to the coronavirus. Then in July, following a significant spike in cases in the Sunshine State, Trump canceled the Jacksonville events.

# Chapter 6 RNC Convention Day 2 Land of Opportunity Introduction

First lady Melania Trump and Secretary of State Mike Pompeo were the headline speakers on the second night of the 2020 Republican National Convention.

Two of President Donald Trump's children, Eric and Tiffany, also spoke on this, the second evening of the convention.

Secretary Pompeo broke with tradition in addressing the convention as secretary of State from a foreign country. Daniel Cameron is the Kentucky Attorney General. He previously spent two years as Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell's legal counsel.

Pam Bondi, is a former Florida attorney general and a Trump supporter. She offered many reasons to vote for the President and not to vote for Joe Biden.

Larry Kudlow is the director of the US National Economic Counci, praised Trump's handling of the economy and notably described the pandemic's economic effect in the past tense. He is a former financial news host for CNBC. He has sometimes downplayed the severity of the coronavirus outbreak in the US and pushed the president's agenda of reopening the American economy as the best approach to move forward for the nation.

Abby Johnson is an anti-abortion rights activist who previously worked as a Planned Parenthood clinic director before resigning in October 2009 after watching an abortion on an ultrasound.

Jason Joyce is a Maine lobsterman Jason Joyce, who spoke in support of Trump's trade and fisheries policies.

Robert Vlaisavljevich is the Democratic mayor of Eveleth, a mining town in Minnesota. It is a town in which Trump's steel tariffs on imports are very popular.

Myron Lizer, the Navajo Nation Vice President has collaborated with Trump on creating an interagency task force to address the crisis of murdered and missing Indigenous persons

Richard Beasley, Former Federal Bureau of Investigation special agent, had worked in Los Angeles and El Paso, Texas, before retiring. He is now president of private investigations firm Global Intelligence Network.

Jon Ponder was arrested by Beasley and went to prison for bank robbery. After his prison release, he became the founder and CEO of Hope for Prisoners, which helps ex-convicts reenter civilian life. A surprised and thankful Ponder was greeted by President Donald Trump on Tuesday. Trump had just signed a pardon for Jon D. Ponder. Joining Ponder in the White House to receive the pardon were Richard Beasley, the former FBI agent who arrested Ponder for bank robbery in Pahrump in 2004, and Ponder's wife, Jamie. They were thrilled.

Mary Ann Mendoza is an "Angel Mom" (a group that is frequently invoked by Trump in his anti-immigrant rhetoric). She was scheduled to speak but did not speak because of some issues. Her son, police sergeant Brandon Mendoza, was killed in 2014 in a head-on collision with a drunken, unauthorized undocumented immigrant who was driving on the wrong side of the road.

Chris Peterson is a dairy farmer in Minnesota who spoke in support of Trump's trade policies that favor American dairy exports

John Peterson, owner and CEO of metal fabricator Schuette Metals in Rothschild, Wisconsin, spoke in support of Trump's steel policies

Cissie Graham Lynch is the granddaughter of the late Rev. Billy Graham. She is an evangelist who served as a spiritual adviser to a number of presidents.

Nick Sandmann provided remarks—very astute for a youngster. Sandmann was in a controversial viral video last year. "'Canceled' is what's happening to people around this country who refuse to be silenced by the far left," Sandmann said. The Kentucky high school student received settlements with CNN and The Washington Post stemming from their coverage of a 2019 confrontation at the Lincoln Memorial. Sandmann, a Covington Catholic High School student

sued CNN for \$275 million (and later settled). This following CNN's biased and unfair coverage of a viral video that showed the youth standing in front of a Native American activist while wearing a MAGA hat.

Ryan Holets, Police Officer, Adopted Drug Addicts daughter after her apprehension.

Eric Trump, the president's son mirrored his father's rhetoric on the culture wars, saying, "The Democrats want an America where your thoughts and opinions are censored when they do not align with their own." A great night ended with a speech from first lady Melania Trump.

Tiffany Trump, the president's daughter hit on similar themes, criticizing tech companies and media organizations for "promoting a biased and fabricated view."

Melania Trump is the First lady of the United States. She delivered a smashing keynote address live. It was very well received by the live audience and the at-home audience. Other speakers include Trump's daughter and White House advisor Ivanka Trump, and Rudy Giuliani, the former New York City mayor and the personal attorney to the president.

## What happened on Thursday evening.

President Trump accepted the Republican nomination for a second term Thursday on a White House lawn packed with excited supporters, as the president he pledged to "defeat the virus" and "again build the greatest economy in history."

It was one of the greatest speeches ever according to attendees and those watching at home, from a defense of his record, optimistic predictions of a COVID-19 vaccine "this year," and a fiery indictment of Democratic nominee Joe Biden that included myriad stories of Biden and the Democrats failure to deal with the challenges of the times, portrayed Biden, a far left Democrat, as "a Trojan horse for socialism" who would grant "free rein to violent anarchists, agitators, and criminals" if he were president. In recent speeches Biden as much as said this is who he is.

"President Trump is a kind and decent man. I wish he could be at his side with me to see his endless kindness to everyone he meets," said White House deputy chief of staff Dan Scavino.

"He is one of the most loyal human beings I've ever met," said Ultimate Fighting Championship President Dana White. Trump's daughter and White House adviser, Ivanka Trump: "I have seen all of my life how my dad believes in the potential of each individual."



Final night of 2020 RNC ends with fireworks display over Washington Monument

Ivanka Trump had nice words to say about her father: "I recognize that my dad's communication style is not to everyone's taste. And I know his tweets can feel a bit unfiltered," Ivanka Trump said. "But the results — the results speak for themselves." The president touted the record-low Black and Hispanic unemployment rates before COVID-19 hit.

Other speakers portrayed the Democratic Party as controlled by its left wing, which Biden defeated in the primary after rejecting a number of its policy ideas.

Rep. Jeff Van Drew, R-N.J., a first-term former Democrat who switched parties last December, said his former party has "moved from liberal to radical" and "become less accepting of American tradition."

The convention included testimonials from men and women of many backgrounds, including Black and Latino Americans and former self-described lifelong Democrats who now favor Trump. They spoke about what the GOP would do in the second term but focused mainly on their case against the Democratic Party.

Former Trump lawyer Rudy Giuliani called Biden "a Trojan horse with Bernie, AOC, Pelosi, Black Lives Matter and his party's entire left wing just waiting to execute their pro-criminal, anti-police policies."

A young man said he had "always been anti-war" in his personal beliefs and argued that "now Trump is, by a mile, the anti-war candidate" in the contest with Biden.

Even if he doesn't win over Sanders supporters, a depressed turnout or third-party swing among left-leaning voters, which occurred in unusually large numbers in 2016, could affect the outcome in November.

To listen to television pundits wrapping up the Republican convention, he received universal acclaim. "This was unquestionably the best Donald Trump production ever," ABC News analyst Sara Fagen said as fireworks burst over Washington. Other Democrats spewed the same hate they have for the past four years. "This was repugnant," said MSNBC's Joy Reid.

The GOP convention ended with hundreds of people joined together at the White House enjoying one of the finest fireworks displays of all-time.

MSNBC went from airing more of the convention at its beginning and gradually showing less, with more fact-checking, as the week went on. Fox News Channel, after some of its fans complained Monday that they were hearing too much from network personalities and not enough of the event, went in the opposite direction.

By far, most American television viewers watching the convention experienced it on Fox News, the favorite destination for the president's fans. More than 7 million people watched the convention's third night on Fox News, while no other network had as much as 2 million, the Nielsen company said.

And this \$130 billion will ultimately go to \$400 billion a year. And Secretary General Stoltenberg who heads NATO was amazed after watching for so many years, and said that president Trump did what no one else was able to do.

Thank you. From the moment I left my former life behind, and it was a good life, I have done nothing but fight for you. I did what our political establishment never expected and could never forgive, breaking the Cardinal rule of Washington politics. I kept my promise. Together we have ended the rule of the failed political class and they are desperate to get their power back by any means necessary, you've seen that. They have their old jobs back, and some are here with us this evening. Please stand. You went through a lot, please stand. Thank you. Thank you very much. You've been through a lot. Last month, I took on Big Pharma. You think that's easy? It's not. And signed orders that will massively lower the cost of your prescription drugs and give critically ill patients access to lifesaving cures.

We passed the decade's long awaited right to try, right to try. We also passed VA Accountability and VA Choice. Our great veterans. We're taking care of veterans. 91% approval rating this month, the VA given by our veterans, first time anything like that's ever happened. By the end of my first term, we will have approved more than 300 federal judges, including two great new Supreme Court Justices.
